Pooler Recreation Complex - First Parking Lot Behind YMCA

In honor of Georgia's Arbor Day, please partner with the City of Pooler, The Greenery, Inc. and The Garden Club of Pooler to select a tree for free to plant at your home. Each resident will be required to sign a hold harmless waiver at the event.

This is Councilwoman Karen Williams' second annual initiative for greenspace improvement fully supported by the City of Pooler, and she has worked diligently with The Greenery on this project. There will be 350 trees available to Pooler residents on a first-come, first-served basis (one per household). Six different indigenous species, including Crape Myrtles, Chaste Tree 'Shoal Creek', Red Maple, Eastern Palatka Holly, Eastern Red Bud, and River Birch, will be available in their dormant stage ranging from four to six feet in height. A Certified Arborist will be on hand to answer any questions.
